Grade 5-8 Yellow Bus Transportation

The school district is experiencing a critical shortage of school bus drivers. This will affect our students in many ways. If you are a grade 5-8 parent and do not intend to have your child ride a yellow bus one or both ways, please call the BPS transportation office at 816-4895 as soon as you receive this communication. This will help the district to consolidate routes and get our students to and from school on-time.
