COVID Testing

30% of staff and students at CHS will continue to be randomly tested for COVID each week pursuant to current district procedures. This year, CHS will conduct the more accurate and less invasive 24-hour turnaround mandatory Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) testing for COVID-19. **We encourage all staff and students to participate in testing in order to reduce the number of times individuals will need to be tested.** Families are asked to <u>use this link</u> to provide consent to include their child in the pool of students to be tested.

Daily COVID-19 Health Screener

Families should complete the daily health screener once again each day BEFORE their child leaves for school. This link will take you to this year's screener. Families are encouraged to paste the link into the 'reminder' app on their smart phone to alert you each morning.

Tomorrow Morning (Wednesday)

Students who do not have a schedule for some reason or who are missing a homeroom assignment are asked to report to the auditorium when they arrive tomorrow morning where they will receive assistance from a school counselor. All students will receive final copies of their schedule during homeroom and hand-in their draft schedules. Their permanent schedule will be printed on pink paper.

Student Laptop Distribution at CHS

The district has informed us that our students will receive their laptop computers on September 13 and 14. Our teachers will provided instruction and materials that do not require access to a computer until laptops have been distributed.

Attention Grade 9 Families

Each year, grade 9 students at CHS are offered the opportunity to join the CHS Science Research Program. This four year program places CHS students working and researching in labs on the Buffalo Niagara Medical Campus at Roswell Park, Hauptman-Woodward and the UB School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences. Program coordinator, Mr. Richards, will hold an informational session for all grade 9 students and parents on **Wednesday, Sepetmber 15 at 7:00pm**. We ask that parents and students enter the meeting five minutes before the start time as Mr. Richards will share a brief presentation followed by reflections from current SRP students as well as time for questions and answers.
