APPLICATION PROCESS: (APPLICANT MUST)

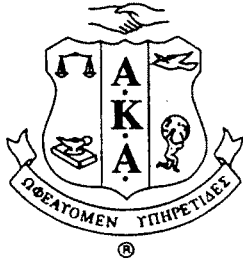
- Submit completed application form.
- Submit three (3) letters of recommendation from the following: School Professional (Guidance Counselor, Principal, Teacher, etc.), Personal Reference, Community Person, Religious Leader, and/or Employer.
- Have her Guidance Counselor send a copy of the applicant's **official transcript** with the application.
- If selected as a finalist, be available for an interview, which will be scheduled for the week of **April 12, 2010**.

Deadline for application is March 19, 2010. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.

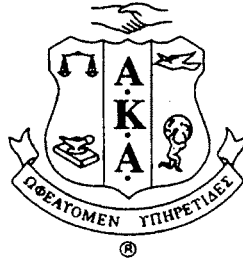
