Objective

The object of the Erie County Fire Chiefs Mutual Aid Organization Scholarship is to enhance academic achievement at the college level for all Jr. Firefighters, Firefighters, and member of a Firefighter's immediate family in Erie County. The Erie County Chiefs will award \$1000.00 scholarships annually for the academic year commencing in September.

Eligibility

Scholarships shall be awarded to any Jr. Firefighters, Firefighters, and Firefighter's immediate family (husband, wife, son, daughter, or step child) who is in good standing of a recognized fire company or department within the boundaries of Erie County who are currently, or will be attending an accredited institution of higher learning. *Eligibility will be limited to fully matriculated students.* (at least 12 credit hours)

Applications

Applicants must complete all sections of the application.

A letter of recommendation from the Chief or President of the applicants own Fire Company or Department must be submitted with the application on the Fire Company or Department stationary.

A copy of your acceptance letter must also be submitted with your application for first year students.

A copy of your transcript from your previous semester for those who have completed their previous year.

A statement of your career plans.

The deadline for receiving scholarship applications will be April 30th for the academic year commencing the following September. No applications will be accepted after April 30th applications must be completely filled out incomplete applications will not be considered.

Selection

Selection of the scholarship winners will be determined at a time and place designated by the Scholarship Committee. All scholarship applicants will be notified by email, phone or mail of their selection or denial.
